## Feedback Analysis Report

## Introduction and Objectives:

Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's,Shri.Raosaheb Ramrao Patil Mahavidyalaya, Savlaj was established in the year 1991. The college aims at the overall development of the students to become entrepreneurs and professionals in the respective disciplines. Every year a survey was conducted to assess the satisfaction of all the stakeholders (Students, Alumni, Teachers, and Employers) regarding curriculum of the college. The college is permanently affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur and follows curriculum prescribed by the university. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these stakeholders is important as both these are crucial in helping monitor and evaluate the academic and administrative activities in the college. Listening to what stakeholders have to say is a contributing factor to running a successful college or institution.

## Methodology:

In every academic year, we ask all the stakeholders to fill a feedback form which is made available on college website. Every year, data is collected during the period from $1^{\text {st }}$ March to $10^{\text {th }}$ March for this academic year data was collected during the period $1^{\text {st }}$ June to $20^{\text {th }}$ June 2022 the link of feedback form was made available to all stakeholders on their Email address, WhatsApp account and also college website. Filling of feedback is voluntary.
For the academic year 2021-22, there were 485 registered students at the college. Sixty-four (64) final year students, 60 alumni, 18 teachers and 7 employers responded to the survey. The analyses presented in this report are based on the responses of these stakeholders to the survey.

## Design of Feedback

The responses from the students are collected on the two-point scale.

1) Yes
2) No

The responses from the teachers are collected on the four-point scale.

1) A: 76-100 Marks
2) B:51-75 Marks
3) C:26-50 Marks
4) D:0-25 Marks

The responses from alumni are collected on the four-point scale.

1) Excellent
2) Good
3) Satisfactory
4) Unsatisfactory
and employer's feedbacks are collected on the four-point Likert scale

5) Excellent
6) Good
7) Satisfactory
8) Poor

## Overall Evaluation

Feedback analysis report of all Stakeholders, Academic Year 2021-22
Feedback was collected and analyzed by Feedback Analysis Committee of the college. Opinion of all stakeholders are obtained about each parameter in percentage.

## Student Feedback

The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to gender, programme level and course. We have received 64 students' online feedback on the syllabus of various programs designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There are 41 female and 23 male respondents in the survey sample.
Following chart and table shows the summary of the responses given by students for each parameter.

About $95 \%$ students agree with the current syllabus which is suitable for employment and entrepreneurship whereas $5 \%$ do not agree with it. About $95 \%$ students are agree with the current syllabus plays positive role into the personality development. More than $94 \%$ students agree with the curriculum which develop global competence, whereas $6 \%$ do not agree with it. About $95 \%$ students agree with the syllabus add value of social responsibility and social justice. But there are $5 \%$ students who do not agree with it. About $95 \%$ students agree with the syllabus add value in gender equality, human values and environmental awareness and about $98 \%$ students are satisfied with the use of modern teaching aids. Overall it seems that majority of the students have rated yes for all the points considered here.

## Teachers Feedback on Curriculum



About $89 \%$ teachers gives around $76-100$ marks and $11 \%$ teachers gives 51-75 marks to the course outcomes are understood by students. About $61 \%$ teachers gives 76-100 marks and $39 \%$ teachers gives 51-75 marks to the assessment of student's difficulties regarding syllabus. About $67 \%$ teachers are agree with the allotted time to complete the syllabus is sufficient but $28 \%$ teachers are not agreeing with it. About $56 \%$ teachers are agree with the syllabus offers research possibilities but $44 \%$ teachers are do not agree with it. About $72 \%$ teachers are agree with the curriculum has academic flexibility and $2 \%$ are do not agree with it. About $68 \%$ teachers are agree with that the syllabus includes cross cutting issues like gender and environment but $6 \%$ teachers do not agree with it. Around $67 \%$ teacher's gives $76-100$ marks and $33 \%$ teachers gives $51-75$ marks to classrooms are clean and properly maintained point. About $61 \%$ and $39 \%$ teacher gives 76-100 and 51-75 marks respectively to cleanliness of toilet and washrooms. $67 \%$ teachers are gives $76-100$ marks because they agree that the current syllabus gives opportunity and support to faculty for upgrading their skills and qualifications but $5 \%$ teachers gives $26-50$ mark to that point.

Most of the teachers gives 76-100 marks to the current curriculum of the graduation level. There is $38 \%$ of arts and $21 \%$ from science faculty members who gives 51-75 marks to the
current syllabus. There are also some teachers $(4 \%, 2 \%)$ from science faculty who gives 26 50 and 0-25 marks respectively to the syllabus.

## Alumni Feedback

We have received 60 alumnus online feedbacks on the syllabus of various programmers designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There are 38 female and 22 male respondents in the survey sample. Following chart and table shows the summary (in \%) of the responses given by alumnus for each parameter.

About $38 \%$ alumni says excellent and $57 \%$ says good about the current syllabus which is suitable for employ-ability in the present scenario of students. About $52 \%$ alumni says excellent and $45 \%$ says good to the curriculum which is Knowledge based. About $48 \%$ says excellent and $45 \%$ says good about the current Syllabus is revised by the university as per the requirement of the stakeholders and $7 \%$ of alumni are satisfied with it. About $33 \%$ alumni says excellent, $63 \%$ are says good and $2 \%$ are satisfied also $2 \%$ are not satisfied with
curriculum which is suitable for overall development of students. About $40 \%$ of alumni says excellent and $53 \%$ says good about curriculum develop the global competence of students and $5 \%$ of alumni are satisfy and $2 \%$ are unsatisfied with it. About $45 \%$ alumni says excellent and $53 \%$ says good the current syllabus which is useful for employment of entrepreneurship but $2 \%$ alumni were unsatisfied with it.

Most of the students who did their graduation from arts and science faculty ( $42 \%, 43 \%$ ) completely agree with the current syllabus adopted by institution, whereas some of the alumnus $3 \%$ from arts faculty and $4 \%$ from science faculty satisfied with it.

There are about $57 \%$ employers says excellent and $29 \%$ says good whereas $14 \%$ are satisfied with the current syllabus is knowledge based. About $72 \%$ employers believe in the current syllabus which incorporates the relevant skills whereas $14 \%$ are satisfied with it. About $85 \%$ employers agree that the current syllabus helps in emphasizing innovative thinking and $14 \%$ are satisfied with it. About $43 \%$ and $57 \%$ employers re agree with the relevant technology taught by the curriculum. About $86 \%$ employers agree with the development of professional ethics targeted by the curriculum whereas $14 \%$ are satisfied with it. About $57 \%$ employers are says that level of competency in the relevant field that the curriculum can create in the student. About $86 \%$ employers agrees that behavior with the colleagues/people also contribution to development of organization/nation is excellent. Most of the employers (71\%) are satisfied with the current syllabus.
